

ALPHABETICAL STRATEGIC RECOVERY [Note: These quotations are in KJV, otherwise stated]

A – Awake – “Awake to righteousness, and do not sin; for some do not have the knowledge of God. I speak *this* to your shame” (1 Cor. 15:34).

Arise – “Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee” (Isa. 60:1).

B – Born-Again – “Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever” (1 Pet. 1:23 (KJV)).

Blood of Jesus – “But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ” (Eph. 2:13).

C – Covenant – “Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree”. “This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more” (Gal. 3:13; Heb. 10:16-17).

D – Decree – “Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways” (Job 22:28).

E – Encourage – “But charge Joshua, and encourage him, and strengthen him: for he shall go over before this people, and he shall cause them to inherit the land which thou shalt see”. “And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God” (Deut. 3:28; 1 Sam. 30:6).

F – Faith – “For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him” (Gal. 3:26; Heb. 11:6).

G - Grace – “Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ”. "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast” (1 Cor. 1:3; Eph. 2:8-9).

Glory – “And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it”. "The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts” (Isa. 40:5; Haggai 2:9).

H – Holy Spirit – “And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption” (Eph. 4:30).

Healing – “Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise” (Jer. 17:14).

I – Inheritance – “In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will”. "The LORD is the portion of mine inheritance and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot” (Eph. 1:11; Psalms 16:5).

J – Jesus – “That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father” (Phil. 2:10-11).

Joy – “And the disciples were filled with joy, and with the Holy Ghost” (Acts 13:52).

K – Kindness – “Blessed be the LORD: for he hath shewed me his marvellous kindness in a strong city” (Psalms 31:21).

L – Love – “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life”. "Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. We love him, because he first loved us” (John 3:16; 1 John 4:11, 19).

M – Mercy – “For great is thy mercy toward me: and thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell”. “O satisfy us early with thy mercy; that we may rejoice and be glad all our days” (Psa. 86:13; Psa. 90:14).

N – New – “Behold, the former things are come to pass, and new things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them”. “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new” (Isa. 42:9; 2 Cor. 5:17).

O – Obey – “But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries” (Exo. 23:22).

Overcome – “He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son” (Rev. 21:7).

P – Peace – “Grace unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ”. “Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God” (2 Thess. 1:2; Matt. 5:9).

Q – “Quench Not The Spirit” – (1 Thess. 5:19).

R – Restore – “Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit”. “For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeketh after” (Psa. 51:12; Jer. 30:17).

Redeem – “For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth” (Job 19:25).

S – Salvation – “The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?” (Psa. 27:1).

T – Trust – “Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths” (Prov. 3:5-6).

Thanksgiving – “In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you”. "Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place” (1 Thess. 5:18; 2 Cor. 2:14).

U – Unity – “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!” "Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ” (Psa. 133:1; Eph. 4:13).

V – Victory – “But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ”. "For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith” (1 Cor. 15:57; 1 Jn. 5:4).

W – Worship – “And the man bowed down his head, and worshipped the LORD”. "O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth” (Gen. 24:26; Psa. 96:9).

Wait – “Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD” (Psa. 27:14).

X – Xerxes – “King Xerxes replied to Queen Esther and to Mordecai the Jew, “Because Haman attacked the Jews, I have given his estate to Esther, and they have impaled him on the pole he set up” (Esther 8:7 (NIV))

Y – “Yes be Yes” – “But let your ‘Yes’ be ‘Yes,’ and your ‘No,’ ‘No.’ For whatever is more than these is from the evil one” (Matt. 5:37 (NKJV)).

Z – Zeal – “For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me” (Psa. 69:9).
