Curing Loneliness

"I'm with you always even until the end of the world" Matt. 28:20

2020 - "MY YEAR OF MANIFESTING INDESTRUCTIBLE LIFE"

"Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life" Heb. 7:16

My pastoral work and involvement in ministry for over three decades have opened me up to the private life of people; it is a matter of trust, which I respect.

I had thought of loneliness as always being the problem of singles or the unmarried, but I have discovered that the married, even with children, are lonely, some worse than the singles and the unmarried. It is a frustrating feeling, to the point of destruction, if not carefully handled. I also discovered that loneliness is not the same as being alone. People are alone through circumstances or choice. Being alone can be experienced as positive, pleasurable, and emotionally refreshing if it is under an individual's control.

In my walk with God, I enjoy being alone, communicating and fellowshiping with God. I always look forward to it. It is awesomely refreshing and profitable. "Then Jacob was left alone" (Gen. 32:24). Being alone may not be due to lack of companionship but setting yourself apart for profitable purposes. Alone emphasizes being apart from others but does not necessarily imply unhappiness, whereas loneliness often connotes painful awareness of being alone. It is more than a feeling of wanting company or wanting to do something with another person. Loneliness is a feeling of being cut off, disconnected, and alienated from other people.

Loneliness is unwilling solitude, an unbearable feeling of separation at a profound level; going about life with a sense of emptiness and isolation, which can manifest feelings of abandonment, rejection, depression, insecurity, anxiety, hopelessness, unworthiness, and resentment.

I have met with so many people who are pushed to loneliness because of the feeling that nobody understands them. Some confess that it is difficult to find truly loving and sincere friends. I hear people say, "I'm always unfortunate with friends," "I'm always attracted to

bad people," "My friends are unfriendly," or "People always repay my good gesture with evil." No doubt, your choice of friendship can collapse or ruin what has taken you years of hard labor to build. Yet loneliness is not the remedy. In praying and counseling people who are lonely and grieving, I have seen them resent every way to help them out. A young lady once said to me, "How can I tolerate or bear when people vent their emotions, blow off steam, complain, unload their problems, and talk about things that are irrelevant or misleading? I choose this path of loneliness even though I do not enjoy it." Her case can be likened to the saying of the messianic prophet of old, "I was wounded in the house of my friends" (Zech. 13:6). I encouraged her by letting her know that she still will have to deal with people, one way or the other, and that this conflict will reveal her strength of character.

While you get along with one, you are always in constant conflict with another. I believe that a better way to cure loneliness and not to be victim of negative people is to sincerely ask yourself why you need friends. Of a truth, you need friends, good ones, although without defining your purpose, you may fall victim. This is one of the questions I ask people desiring to be cured from loneliness: Why do you need friends? I get varying answers. Some say for companionship, for acceptance, to avoid loneliness, to ease off pains and pressures, and for support.

I once heard somebody say in all sincerity, "I choose friends because I need people I can boss around." This brings me to the next question I ask people desiring to be cured from loneliness: Why do people choose you as a friend? I have discovered that people want me as friend because of who I am and what I represent. Some want to be my friend because of what I have been willing to do for them. I am aware that so many people commit themselves to relationships only if it is profitable to them. So I

ask myself, Who is a true friend? I can answer this question by describing what type of friends I keep, their motives, and the level of their commitment.

TYPES OF FRIENDS

The life of Job in the Bible made him discover true friendship. He was a wealthy and influential family man; above all else, he was a God-fearing righteous man. He had lots of friends, some who were close associates and others who were very close friends. His trials and losses made him discover who was a true friend. He was rejected and ridiculed by friends and relatives, and even by his wife.

If you are feeling nobody understands you, I guess you need to understand yourself first before others can understand you. Maybe you have an unwelcoming attitude that needs to change.

"Then his wife said to him, 'Do you still hold fast to your integrity? Curse God and die!' But he said to her, 'You speak as one of the foolish women speaks. Shall we indeed accept good from God, and shall we not accept

adversity?' In all this Job did not sin with his lips" (Job 2:9–10). No doubt, good relationships have been built through the years, but they cannot cope with the pressure of trials.


Miserable Comforters

"Then Job answered and said: 'I have heard many such things; Miserable comforters are you all!' (Job 16:1–2). These are people who can cause great discomfort and distress to us. What are friends

for? They may be cheerful, elated, happy, and merry; but a relationship like this can make you suffer from prolonged anguish.

Unfortunately, this kind of person may think they are helping you, but instead they trouble you with their suggestions and advice, making matters

worse and leaving you more confused than ever.

Worthless Physicians

“But you forgers of lies, you are all worthless physicians. Oh, that you would be silent, and it would be your wisdom!” (Job 13:4–5). Physicians of no value are people who should bring healing influence to you, but do not. They are expected to be valuable and helpful during a crisis, but are indifferent to your need and cry. They will watch you fall and waste away. It is tragic to be surrounded by people whom you feel will be a source of strength, but discover they have nothing to offer you when you need them.

so many people who feel lonely, rejected, and abandoned have opened up their lives for attacks by involving themselves in things that turn around to hurt them.

Betrayer Friends

The life of King David also exposed him to different kinds of friendship. He could liken some friends as betrayer friends.

What are friends for? Faithfulness, loyalty, protection, and support. But a friend who violates trust is a betrayer. Many relationships have been jeopardized through betrayal. It is traumatic and detrimental to experience betrayal in relationship. Great kings have been captured through betrayal, and so many people have been handed over to their tormentors through betrayal. Let’s read the account of King David on betrayal friends, “Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, who ate my bread, has lifted up his heel against me. But You, O Lord, be merciful to me, and raise me up, that I may repay them” (Ps. 41:9–10). “For it is not an enemy who reproaches me; then I could bear it. Nor is it one who hates me who has exalted himself against me; then I could hide from him. But it was you, a man my equal, my companion and my acquaintance. We took sweet counsel together, and walked to the house of God in the throng” (Ps. 55:12–14).

Fair-weather Friends

A person who is dependable in good times but not in times of trouble-this kind of person will do anything for you when things are going good for you. As long as you can keep up what attracted them to you, they remain friends. They are present and

dependable only in good times; but when there is sudden change into bad conditions, they quietly disappear. Thank God that He alone is the very present help in times of trouble. (See Psalm 46:1.)

Master-Servant Relationships

In a master-servant relationship, one person says to the other, “I must be in control before I can trust you.” Whether by manipulation or deceit, such people want to exercise authoritative or dominating influence over you. They want you to adjust without them making effort to better the relationship. If they are not in charge, nothing else works. They may push you to a position of helplessness until you cannot survive on your own but only look up to them.

Self-seeking Relationships

This kind of person exhibits concern only with promoting one’s own ends or interests. A friend of mine called such people “self-absorbed, self-centered, and selfish friends.” They withdraw easily any help they offer if they will not be profited. Who is a friend? Someone caring, generous, kind, benevolent, and considerate.

But friendship of this sort perceives, understands, and interprets the world in terms of the self. They cannot put themselves in other peoples’ shoes, because they believe everyone sees what they see or that what they see in some way exceeds what others see.

Relationship-driven Friends

There are people who, due to losing a father or mother, brother or sister, are missing this role, and so a void is left. Such people are seeking a true fatherly and motherly figure. They need friends who can fulfill that role of a brother, sister, father, or mother. Some may have their parents or brothers and sisters alive, but never enjoyed a good relationship and thus are seeking who can fulfill the role. They are relationship driven. If they find such and love it, they will stick their lives to it. “There are ‘friends’ who destroy each other, but a

 - In the Court Yard of the Tabernacle 20 pillars/20 sockets made of brass with silver hooks and bands, (Exo. 27:10, 11, 16/38:10-11); and
 - The gate of the Court – 20 cubits curtains, (Exo. 27:16).

Implication:

- Note the frame and the pillars (for support); the covering (curtain) of the gate
- God’s people will enjoy Divine support and covering much more in this new

- decade.
 - 1 shekel = 20 Gerahs (An ancient Hebrew unit of weight and currency) – (Exo. 30:13).
- Implication:** This is the decade we shall be placed in Divine balances – may we measure up to Divine standard and not be found wanting.

- In ancient Israel –
 - Census – 20 years plus – (Num. 1:18);
 - Service – 20 years plus – (2 Chr. 31:17; and)
 - War – 20 years plus – (Exo. 38:26).

A true friend is real. If found, they are reliable, faithful, and sincere. I consider a true friend a companion, confidant, supporter, encourager, and a sympathizer. A true friend is:

- one who promotes and advocates your rightful course in life;
 - someone who sees you at your worst but never forgets your best;
 - someone who thinks you are a little bit more wonderful than you really are;
 - as happy for your success as you are;
 - hears and understands when you share your deepest feelings;
 - will not only spend time with you but invests time with you;
 - will attract other good people to you;
 - someone who will stretch you until you achieve your very best.
- "As iron sharpens iron, so a man sharpens the countenance of his friend" (Prov. 27:17).

A friend who is a friend indeed should be truthful to his or her commitment. People relate with us based on different motives we are ignorant of and which could either be profitable or injurious to us. I have come in contact with many people, and while some left good memories, others did

damage to the point of my regretting ever having met them. I love to associate and fellowship with people, but unfortunately I have opened up to people who later turned around to stab me in the back. I, therefore, can feel the pains and burden of people who are afraid of keeping friends. I have learned through tribulations and persecutions to identify danger signs or whom to avoid as friends. Even though so many people enjoy being my friend, I can now determine what type of

friends they are. Would they build me up or bring me down? Would they be a source of strength and encouragement or draw me back and mess me up? Would they bring out the best in me or reduce me to nothing? I also deeply consider what role I will play as friend and my level of influence. All these determine my extent of commitment.

FINDING A TRUE FRIEND

What is it about some people that makes them so easy to relate to, while others can be so difficult to deal with? How is it that you can get along with one and get into conflict with others? Why is it that you can tolerate some people but cannot stand others, even for a moment, however hard you try? Ask yourself why you jubilate, full of joy, at the sight of some people but try to avoid others. How, then, can I have a good and lasting friend?

Consider yourself friendly. "A man who has friends must himself be friendly" (Prov. 18:24).

Search yourself to discover whether you are incompatible and unsociable in developing intimacy. If you are feeling nobody understands you, I guess you need to understand yourself first before others can understand you. Maybe you have an unwelcoming attitude that needs to change.

Keep your friendships in constant repair. We sometimes take our friendships for granted. Old friendships, as well as new ones, need constant fine-tuning. Do not wait until the relationship is damaged; revitalize it, keep it in sound condition. When we allow a crack in our relationship, we sometimes ignore it until things go beyond repair. But a willingness to restore a relationship to attractive condition will refresh it again. I ask myself, How do I repair my relationships? There are so many ways, but the ones I find so profitable to me are:

- Creating a godly atmosphere of love and faith;
- By sharing memories of past glorious events and hoping for a better future;
- Trying as much as possible to keep my promises. "But above all, my brethren, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or

with any other oath. But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No,' lest you fall into judgment" (James 5:12). I call this principle "unity through humility";

- Making small adjustments for optimal performance;
- If an obstacle or misunderstanding arises, trying to work on it and move past it, else I be overtaken by evil;
- Watching out for those who have little or no respect for my divine purpose.

"Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. You are My friends if you do whatever I command you. No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you" (John 15:13-15). You can be cured from loneliness as you believe God to connect you and order your steps to a friend. More importantly, rejoice because you can find a friend in our Lord Jesus. He loves you no matter what. While we were yet sinners, He paid the price for our redemption.
